03	Not sure Austin's is often more of a social interaction disorder plus sensory issues. People who have an understanding of & work closely with people with autism should be involved
04	Yes Local authorities & NHS often hindered by budgets
05	Need to ask people with autism what they feel is important. They have autism as opposed to being autistic
06	Seems more sensible to have guidance first but that may delay the bill. On the other hand may need to see how it's working to give the best guidance
07	Don't understand why it can't start right away
08	Diagnosis can be a very slow process- some take longer due to lack of staff and some due to staff deciding quickly that the person doesn't have autism. Also getting a diagnosis means access to services so no diagnosis no services- money saved
09	Not sure Think it should happen earlier & maybe even when people are going through the diagnosis
10	Yes People should know the type of people who are making decisions
11	If the person is still in education as teacher or Tutor should be involved - people who work with the person for a longer time as opposed to people who just see them for a short time.
