Legislative Consent Memorandum for the Birmingham Commonwealth Games Bill

We considered the Welsh Government's Legislative Consent Memorandum (LCM) for the Birmingham Commonwealth Games Bill at our meeting on 10 February 2020. In doing so, we reflected on the report we produced in October 2019 on the Welsh Government's LCM for the previous iteration of this UK Bill; a Bill which did not proceed because of last autumn's UK General Election.

It is our understanding that, in terms of provisions in the Bill for which consent is sought, there is no substantive change to those relevant provisions when considering this version of the Bill against the version we reported on last October. We acknowledge that the numbering of the clauses that contain the relevant provisions (for the purpose of the LCM) do differ because of alterations to the numbering in the Bill as a whole.

We note that the Business Committee referred this LCM to us for scrutiny, and asked that we report by 12 March 2020. For the reasons set out above, we have agreed that we will not produce a further report on this LCM.

As our October 2019 report may be beneficial to Assembly Members when the Welsh Government brings forward a legislative consent motion for the Bill, the committee
